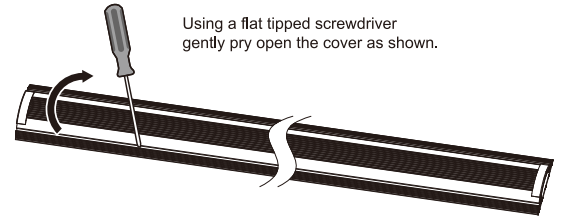

NOTE: Do not remove the end cap screws if you are not cutting the Ducting to a custom size. (Skip to Step 5 for managing cables)

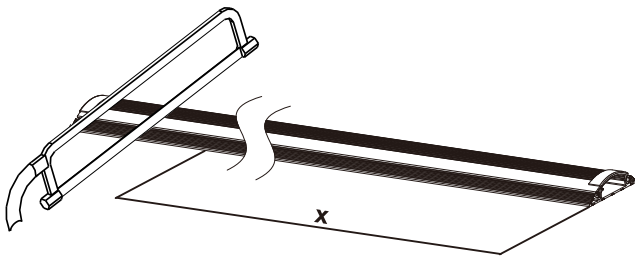

Using a flat tipped screwdriver gently pry open the cover as shown.

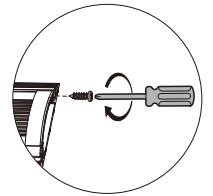

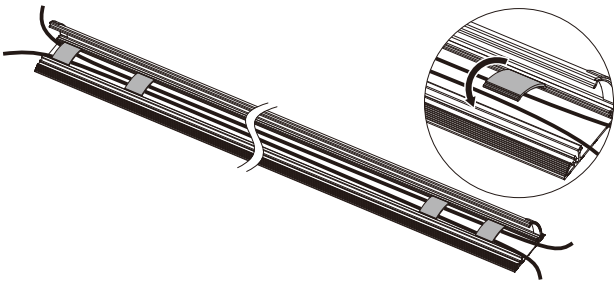
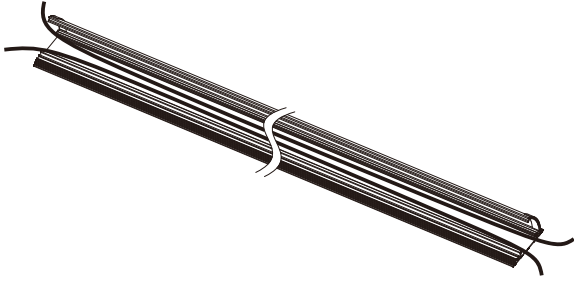
Using a hacksaw cut the ducting to desired length (Keep the cover Closed).

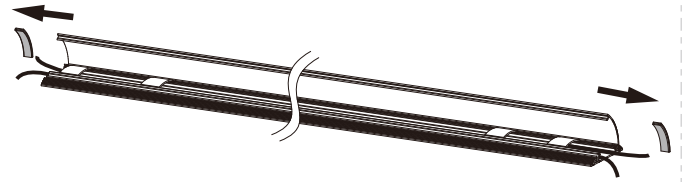

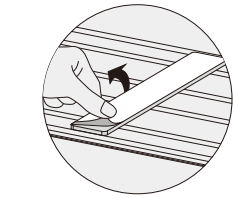
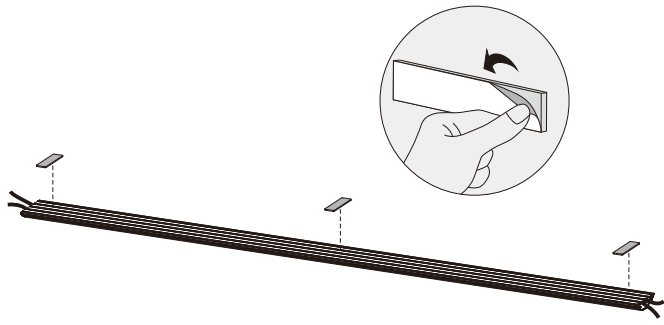
Insert the cables.
NOTE: Route cables within the grooved channels inside the ducting.



Attach the plastic cover to the base to secure cables in place.

To prevent the ducting from moving, attach double-sided tape as required.
NOTE: Double-sided tape is recommended when using the ducting on hard floors.
